



**The Shakespearean
Script Flip

Rules and Procedure:

Round 1:

- Delegate cap: 2-3

- The first round of the Shakespearean Script-Flip will consist of two halves. In the first half, delegates will have to compete with one another in a trivia, focusing on all of Shakespeares plays. The second half will follow a game of “matching the prop to the play”, where each team will be given three chances to guess correctly and score. Only one delegate from each team will be allowed to guess at one time. All in all this will be there scoring round for this category.

Round 2:

- Delegate cap: Maximum 5

- In the second round, each delegate will be given an excerpt from a Shakespearean play, and asked to rewrite it using modern-day slang and language, as if it’s from a tv show, sitcom or so. With the challenging addition of a character or prop from another one of Shakespeares plays, that will be chosen at random and assigned by the dias. Delegates will be given 45 minutes to write their scripts, with an individual time off 5-8 minutes to perform. Delegates will be required to turn in the scripts prior to their performance. The best out of these along with the score from the first round will be selected as the victor. It is to note that any portrayal of high degrees of violence, profanity, obscenity, drug abuse, and any other offensive and/or triggering material will not be tolerated.
